Changing the Grade of a Mastery Test


1. Log in to Plato. Click on the "Assignments" mini-app.




2. Find the assignment in the location selector and put a check mark next to the assignment.




3. Choose "Manage Assignment" from the drop-down menu.



4. Once you are in the manage assignment screen, put a check mark next to the student's name. Then click "Edit Status, Single Learner."




5. This will take you to a screen that will allow you to find the specific mastery test that you want to unlock. Click on the "+" signs to open out the assignment until you find the mastery test.




6. Once you find the specific mastery test, click edit on the right side of the page.
